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### What are Tricky Words?

There are no tricky words used in this book.

These are high-frequency words that have at least one phonics element that hasn't been introduced. For example, "is" uses the letter "s" for the sound /z/.

As students learn new phonics elements, words that are counted as "tricky" will change.

### What are Word Types?

This refers to the pattern of consonants and vowels in a word. For example, CVC refers to a consonant-vowel-consonant word like "ran".

### How do I teach Consonant Blends?

In consonant blends, such as the "n" and "d" in the word "and", each letter represents a different sound. There is not a separate "nd" sound that needs to be taught.
